Applications are welcome from candidates from any of the major social science disciplines (e.g., administrative sciences, economics, law, political science, sociology). Background knowledge of medical or relevant technical sciences is a plus, including public health. The position is full-time and intended to be filled at the level of full professor. The position is for five years, and can be extended. The expected start date is 1 February 2019.

We are interested in candidates with demonstrated capacity for independent research at the highest levels in their discipline, through an established record of publication in top outlets. The Hertie School seeks faculty with a commitment to intensive, high-quality teaching and innovative research of potential interest to the international scholarly community and policy-makers. Candidates are expected to show full commitment to working in an interdisciplinary, international environment with English as the language of instruction and operation. The successful candidate will teach courses in the School's Master, Executive, and PhD programmes.

We offer an internationally competitive salary in line with the candidate's qualifications, excellent working conditions, a vibrant research environment, and a lively community of policy debate in the political heart of Germany.

The Hertie School particularly encourages applications from female scholars and from candidates with international backgrounds.
